

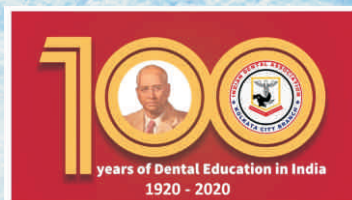

The Nickel Titanium alloy has made a such a big difference that most people world over have switched over to NiTi rotary files for shaping. Over the decades, a staggering array of files have been produced by different manufacturers. Recently files with Heat Treatment are introduced with improved properties like much higher resistance against the breakage due to Cyclic Fatigue and Torsion.

## **BONE REGENERATION FOR IMPLANTS : SCIENCE, TECHNIQUES & BIOMATERIALS**

Dental implants are the mainstay of oral rehabilitation these days, but the tissues presented to the implantologist are often bereft of adequacy to place implants in a prosthetically desirable position. This lecture focuses on science and protocols for augmentation of the hard and soft tissues to achieve the bulk required to place implants in a predictable manner.

## **NOIS : THE TWILIGHT STATE FOR DENTISTRY**

Dental treatment is always identified with Pain and Discomfort. Due to this many people avoid dental treatment and suffer from chronic neglect. Nitrous Oxide- Oxygen Inhalation Sedation (NOIS) is used to put the patients in a TWILIGHT stage of consciousness, reduce anxiety and make the patients relax during dental procedures. NOIS is an invaluable addition to the dental practice and safely used on children and adults. This lecture is to introduce NOIS and demonstration of this concept will follow in a NOIS apparatus.



## **CHANGING CONCEPTS IN DENTAL IMPLANTS**

Ever since Prof. P. I. Branemark advocated the protocol of dental implant placement in alveolar bone, dentistry started enjoying the clinical success. But sufficient alveolar bone in quantity and quality are the prerequisites for optimal housing of implants. If enough bone is not available, the deficiency of alveolar bone is compensated through time-consuming, expensive and precision-driven surgical endeavours like bone augmentation or bone transplantation with or without sinus lifting; these are not hundred percent result-oriented.

## **INSTRUMENT SEPARATION – MANAGEMENT & RETRIEVAL**

**Dr. Narasimhan Bharadwaj**

Although Rotary Instrumentation has revolutionized Endodontic treatment in the last 2 decades, it has also enhanced dentist's enigma pertaining to instrument separation. Innumerable literature is available on the causes & prevention of instrument separation; however, the exact reason and time of separation still remains obscure. Retrieval of separated instrument depends on a number of factors like which canal, position in the canal, straight portion or curved portion of the canal, type of instrument etc. The advent of Microscopes coupled with Ultra sonics in Endo practice has made instrument retrieval a reality.

## **IMPLANT SUPPORTED FULL-ARCH RECONSTRUCTION : VARIOUS PROSTHETIC OPTIONS**

Edentulism is associated with compromised aesthetic, functional and psychological complications. Rehabilitation of a completely edentulous patient present a challenge to the dentist. Previously complete dentures were the only treatment options for such patients. Evolution of implant supported removable prosthesis and fixed prosthesis has become an integral part of prosthodontic treatment planning.



## **PROTOCOLS & MANAGEMENT OF MEDICAL EMERGENCIES DURING ROUTINE DENTAL CARE.**

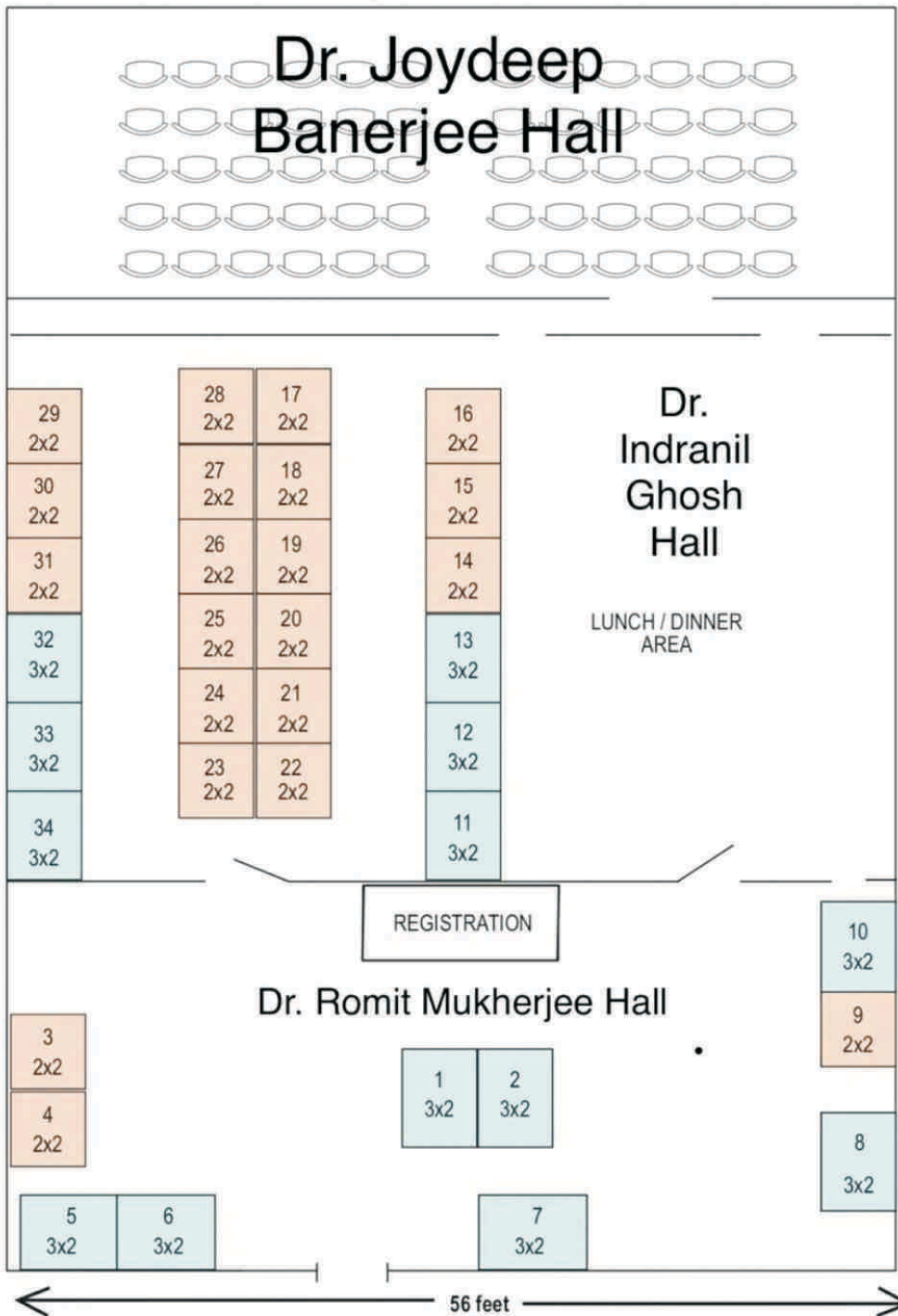
