


IBCMJS

Rotary Club of Calcutta became the central piece and information centre.




Bally Bridge 1925


Annual Children's Treat 28 Dec 1925


Howrah Bridge 1927







Our Club Persuaded Government Advocating Change on Indian Railways Sanitation Facilities

Water and Sanitation Rotarian Action Group(Wasrag) under Rotary International, Newsletter (May 2011)

"Sanitation facilities on trains in India still often consist of waste dropping onto the tracks - polluting and spreading disease. Rotary Club of Calcutta sent a letter to the Minister of Railways in Kolkata. Although things are improving in India, the practice on the rail system of emptying toilet contents directly onto the railway tracks has not changed.


Subsequently, Indian Railways undertook several steps to improve the toilet systems on trains. Government responded positively

Many coaches have now been updated with a Control Discharge Toilet System (CDTS) and an agreement signed regarding biotoilets. Trials with vacuum retention toilets (like on airplanes) and Zero discharge toilet systems, are planned."
