## **Rights of the Fellow**

1. The Fellow will have the right to ask any queries to the advisor related to the program.
2. The Fellow will have the right to use the library facility of the hospital. However, he cannot carry the books outside the library.
3. The Fellow will have the right to use the equipments of the hospital on patients and for practice which is related to the program.
4. The successful fellow will have right to receive a Certificate of Fellowship of the Susrut Eye Foundation. He will have the right to use the suffix "Fellow of Susrut Eye Foundation (Clinical Optometry)" after his name.
5. In case of any grievances students can contact Director of Students Affairs .

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## **Responsibility of the Fellow**

1. The Fellow will need to attend all the lecture and Demonstration classes in time.
2. The Fellow will have to abide by the rules and regulations of the institute and the hospital.
3. In addition to the lecture and demonstration classes the Fellow will need to attend hospital's OPD between 9.00 AM to 4.30 PM on all six days of the week during the tenure of the course.
4. The Fellow will have to practice on Patients in camps deputed by the hospital or institute from time to time and make a case report of each case seen. The case report so made will have to be discussed with respective faculty and get corrected by him. All such reports have to be submitted to the Program co-ordinator at the end of the program.
5. The fellow has to pay his entire fees by demand draft or cheque drawn in favor of "Himalaya Susrut Eye Foundation & Research Centre Charitable Trust". The payment can be made in two installments as under:
  - At the time of Admission Rs. 5000/-
  - On or before 30<sup>th</sup> Sept'10 Rs. 2000/-
6. There will be three advisors to assist the fellow in activities related to the program. The advisor will provide guidance to the fellow during the program with respect to any queries, demonstration and clarification. The names of the two advisors are:

7. The fellow will have to submit his projects to the program co-ordinator at the end of the program together with the corrected case reports.
8. The Fellow will take necessary care for the hospital equipments and will need to ensure they are locked and switched off when not in use.

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## Rule & Regulations of the Institute

2. The Fellow is not allowed to smoke or eat anything inside the hospital and institute premises.
3. The Fellow cannot carry the mobile phone in the lecture room. However, he can carry the same in OPDs where he needs to keep it in the silent mode.
4. The Fellow will have to maintain the necessary discipline in the classes and during the OPDs. He needs to wear white apron during his presence in OPDs.
5. The Fellow should leave the institute premises as soon as the classes are over. Group discussion in and around the institute premises is not allowed.
6. The Fellow must behave in a professional manner at all times while in the institute and the hospital premises.
7. Attendance is strictly essential as stipulated by your course. Attendance falling short of 85% will not be eligible for the certification.

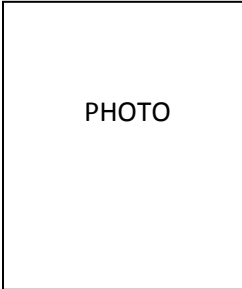
